Music lovers this is the concert you cannot miss!

Famous French singer, pianist, guitar player, Martin Rappeneau will perform a special concert in Nexus Cabaret featuring Adelaide String Quartet: Aurora Strings as part of his first Australian Tour.

Martin Rappeneau grew up listening to delicate and moving scores written by Michel Legrand for his father, the film-maker Jean-Paul Rappeneau. He often describes his music as 'amorous glimpses of a fragment of life', mixing autobiographical memories with a love of stage performance. While studying law, he sang, composed and played in piano bars. He developed his new skill without any help and then recorded a cd at the Conservatoire de Paris. If his repertoire is today tinted with funky accents it is thanks to the influence of Sinclair who he met by chance in a café in 1999. Three years later Martin Rappeneau recorded his first album 'La Moitié des choses' with the help of his new friend. He has made a name for himself with skilful melodies such as "Les Figures imposées" (which he will later sing in a duo with Marie Gillain). A shy seducer, it is while on stage with his piano that he conquers his public.
