

Linguistic Stays in France

Imagine taking a French course in one of France's most beautiful cities, staying with a French family, totally immersed in French culture. The Alliance Française d'Adelaïde can organise this experience of a lifetime in any of the following cities: Lyon, Nice, Paris, Rouen, Strasbourg and Toulouse.

The program includes French courses at the Alliance Française in your city of choice and accommodation with a family who will provide breakfast and dinner for the duration of your stay.

In general, a linguistic stay of four weeks is most beneficial and as such, the average stay is one month in duration. However, if you plan to be in Europe and find that you have a couple of weeks free in your scheduled travel plans, shorter stays are available in some cities.

Courses are on-going throughout the year, so once you have a departure date in mind, please contact us to discuss options for your linguistic stay.

Diplomas & Accreditations

Accredited by the French Ministry of Education as the official examination centre for **DEL**F and **DAL**F in South Australia, the Alliance Française d'Adelaïde holds examination sessions usually twice a year, in March and again in November.

DEL

F and DALF consist of six independent diplomas, each one corresponds to one of the six levels of the Common European Framework Reference. The tests for each diploma evaluate the following four skills: oral comprehension and expression, written comprehension and expression.

These diplomas can be sat for and obtained independently from each other, in the same country or in a different country and with no set timeframe.

We can also organise the **TCF** (test de connaissance de français). This can be organised with more flexibility and does not have to be done at set times throughout the year. Ask our director for more details.

ACCREDITATION

- The Alliance is accredited by the Ethnic Schools Board of South Australia;
- The Alliance is a member of the Ethnic Schools Association of South Australia;
- The Alliance is accredited by SACE Board of South Australia; and
- The Alliance is the official examination centre for the DELF & DALF exams (run by the French Ministry of Education in South Australia).

Terms and Conditions

COURSES: ★ New students who ARE NOT complete beginners are required to have their level assessed prior to joining a class.

1. To ensure high quality teaching, the Alliance Française d'Adelaïde reserves the right to redirect a student to another French course within the Alliance Française d'Adelaïde if the student is not at the same level as the rest of the class.
2. Course fees are calculated on the basis of a required minimum of seven (7) students per class. If the required number of students is not reached within two (2) lessons, the Alliance Française d'Adelaïde reserves the right to cancel the class or modify the course fees to reflect the lower number of students.
3. In the event that a course is cancelled, the student will be offered an alternative course. However, should a suitable class be unavailable, the student will be refunded in full, less the cost of any lessons already held / attended.
4. Re-enrolment is NOT automatic, and must be done by the student him/herself at Reception, with payment in full
5. Classes are not held on Public Holidays and the fees are adjusted accordingly.

PAYMENT:

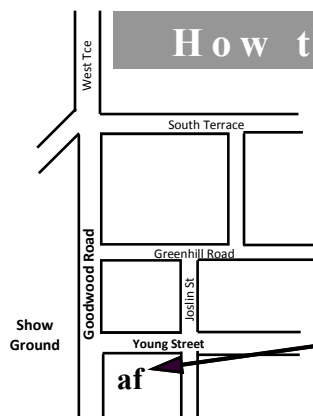
1. All courses must be paid for at the time of enrolment. The student must pay ALL FEES upfront, prior to the commencement of the course. All class fees include a **non-refundable \$50 enrolment fee.**
2. Fees are paid per term and are independent of the number of classes held per course.
3. There will be NO CREDIT OR REFUND should the student fail to attend every class, or withdraw before the end of the term.
4. If a student, having paid the appropriate fee, withdraws before the beginning of a course, the full amount paid, minus 20% cancellation fee will be refunded.

DISCOUNTS:

1. A 10% discount is available for holders of the following: Senior's Card, Health Care Card, Pension Card or Full-time Tertiary Student Card. This discount does not apply to special offers.
2. A 5% discount on the total course fee is available where two (2) or more family members enrol in the same term.
3. Available discounts are NON-CUMULATIVE and do not apply to private tuition.

PLEASE NOTE:

1. If at the time of registration, you know that you will have to miss any lessons, you can ask for a discounted price. In this case, the fee structure will be the number of lessons you are able to attend PLUS a 10% administration fee. Please contact Reception **prior** to enrolling.
2. All prices include GST, except where specified.
3. **Enrolment in any of our courses implies that you have read, understood and that you agree to abide by these terms and conditions.**
